

ENVIRONMENT FOR FORMING THE FAMILY VALUE SYSTEM

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ABSTRACT

The capabilities of the family as a social institution are understood as the assimilation by children of the values formed and practiced by parents and their transmission to the next generation. The educational capabilities of the family are a complex of factors and conditions that ensure the comprehensive development of children in the family, including the family environment, the family's lifestyle, and its capabilities in spiritual and practical activities. As can be seen from this table, the educational-activity (technological) level of the socio-pedagogical capabilities of the family is a means of ensuring the implementation of the pedagogical capabilities of parents in raising a child. It is manifested in:

- in family relationships;

In psychology, the concept of “social and cultural level of socio-psychological potential of the family” is widely used, which means what parents have and what they can give to their child, for what benefit they perform this action. The following elements of such a level exist: literacy of parents;

- spiritual and moral culture of parents and its manifestation;
- religious and cultural traditions and values that are practiced by parents in family life and child upbringing;
- culture of organizing family leisure.

The role of social values in the structure of a person's personal values is incomparable, and family values of a person occupy a special place in this. Family values, in a broad sense, are considered the ultimate goal and ideal form of child upbringing and development, based on the socio-cultural environment in the family, and reflect the ways to achieve the goals set for child upbringing, the need for the transfer of culture from the older generation to the next generation. In a relatively brief form, family values, moral and aesthetic requirements developed as a result of family relationships, family traditions, customs. They directly affect the satisfaction of the needs of family members for the upbringing and development of children. Family values are of great importance in the socio-cultural and spiritual qualities of parents, in the goals they set for raising children and the path they choose to achieve them.

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
